

# Glide Guide

The Leland International Glide Guide has been compiled to assist in the selection of the proper glide for your installation. There are many variables to consider while making your selection. The information below is intended to describe typical applications. Because only you understand all the factors in the environment, the responsibility for the final decision of glide type is the responsibility of the customer.

## Felt

Consider felt glides for more delicate flooring such as VCT, LVT, Sheet Vinyl, Tile, or wood (glides which become embedded with foreign matter such as dirt/sand can scratch floors.).

## Floor Saver

Consider Floor Saver glides for porcelain flooring or flooring that may not be meticulously maintained as its shape helps push dirt and grit away from under the glide.

## Metal / Stainless Steel

Consider Metal or Stainless Steel glides for carpet as well as other durable soft surface floors, especially when a flatter surface glide is required to reduce the possibility of snagging.

## Nylon/Polyethylene/Polycarbonate

Nylon glides are the most standard and typical glide used in contract furniture and are most appropriate for carpet as well as other durable flooring surfaces.

## Rubber

Consider rubber glides for more delicate flooring such as VCT, LVT, sheet vinyl, tile, porcelain, or wood. Note that rubber will not move as easily as felt across a floor.
